He also serves as the associate director of Medical Oncology Services at the Georgia Cancer Center. Dr. Jillella is the founding director of the Georgia Cancer Center?s adult stem cell and bone marrow transplant program. Jillella?s current research, funded by the Leukemia/Lymphoma Society, is a novel induction therapy for acute promyelocytic leukemia, a cancer of the white blood cells, which dramatically reduces mortality rates and starts as a national ECOG/ACRIN clinical trial. His clinical focus is bone marrow transplantation for leukemia, multiple myeloma and other blood-related malignancies.
