Anna Nagurney is an expert in transportation networks and congestion management, and supply chain networks and disruption management. Since the start of the Russian war against Ukraine in 2022, Nagurney has been called on to discuss how the war is impacting shipments of food around the world, threatening to worsen shortages. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Nagurney was a go-to expert to discuss supply chain issues related to the crisis. Her commentary and analysis has been sought by news organizations including the New York Times, the Associated Press, NPR, USA Today, the Boston Globe, and the Wall Street Journal.
