Biography

Dr. Kyriacou is an Associate Professor and Interim Vice Dean, School of Health Professions and Human Services School of Health Professions and Human Services at Hofstra University. She was the founding Director of Hofstra's Master of Public Health Program (2012-2016) and Director of the Master of Science in Community Health program (2010-2016). Dr. Kyriacou currently teaches courses in health care policy at both the graduate and undergraduate level, as well as graduate courses in population aging and research project design and implementation (MPH integrative learning experience). Dr. Kyriacou's current research focuses on identifying best practices for establishing a Nassau County Time Bank – a program that builds community by connecting neighbors to trade-needed services and skills. Dr. Kyriacou co-authored a book that explores the social, health, environmental and fiscal implications of innovative, alternative economies, *Equal Time, Equal Value: Community Currencies and Time Banking in the US* (Ashgate, 2012). Dr. Kyriacou received a doctorate in Social Policy and Health Services Research from the Heller School at Brandeis University where she was an Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality Fellow, and she holds a Master of Public Health degree from New York Medical College.
