Dr Meneilly graduated from the Medical School at the University of Saskatchewan in 1978. He did a rotating internship at the Royal Jubilee Hospital in Victoria and subsequently went to the University of Toronto to pursue residency training in Internal Medicine where he was a Chief Resident. He then went to the Harvard Medical School and did a Fellowship in Gerontology and Diabetes. He stayed on the Faculty at Harvard for a number of years. He returned to Canada and took a Faculty position at the University of British Columbia in 1988. He is currently professor and head of the Department of Medicine at the University of British Columbia, Physician-in-Chief at Vancouver General Hospital and Regional Department Head for Vancouver Coastal Health and Providence Health Care.
