Biography

Ian Alexander Moore is Assistant Professor of Philosophy at Loyola Marymount University. He works mostly on continental philosophy (especially Heidegger and post-Heideggerian thought), medieval philosophy (especially Meister Eckhart), and German philosophy's relation to poetry. He is the author of *Heidegger und Trakl auf der Bühlerhöhe* (with Tobias Keiling, Schillergesellschaft 2023); *Dialogue on the Threshold: Heidegger and Trakl* (SUNY 2022), which won the Symposium Book Award of the Canadian Society for Continental Philosophy; and *Eckhart, Heidegger, and the Imperative of Releasement* (SUNY 2019). He is currently co-editing *The Oxford Handbook of Heidegger* and writing a book titled *Heidegger, Metaphysics, and Divinity* for the Cambridge series *Elements in the Philosophy of Martin Heidegger*. He is also writing a book on the lifework of Reiner Schürmann.
