She began her career as a Texas public school teacher, and has been employed at TCU since 2005. Dr. Lacina has served in many leadership positions within higher education, such as Interim Dean, Early Childhood Program Coordinator, and Post Baccalaureate Graduate Program Coordinator. Since 2011, she has served as Associate Dean in TCU?s College of Education. In leadership roles she led programs to win national awards including the AACTE Best Practice Award in Support of Multicultural Education and Diversity, the AACTE/Southern Poverty Law Center Culturally Responsive Teaching Award, the Association of Teacher Educators (ATE) Billy G. Dixon Distinguished Program in Teacher Education Award, as well as the Wisniewski Teacher Education Award presented by the Society of Professors of Education (SPE). Dr. Jan Lacina is the recipient of both the TCU Dean?s Research and Creativity Award and the TCU Dean?s Award for Teaching. Most notably she received the 2023 International Literacy Association Jerry Johns Outstanding Teacher Educator in Reading Award as well as the 2023 Excellence in Action: Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, & Social Justice Award for her leadership as an Associate Dean in Texas. Dr. Lacina holds an appointment as U.S. Ambassador for the United Kingdom Literacy Association through 2028. Dr. Jan Lacina has served as Editor and/or Associate Editor for three major journals within her field, and authored more than 100 publications, including four books. She was Program Lead for the College?s learning by scientific design (LBSD) work, which focused on program improvement and tracking candidate learning outcomes.
