He started teaching part-time at LMU in 2002, joining the faculty full-time in 2004. Prior to that, Dr. Dionisio was a part of the Medical Imaging Informatics group at UCLA, which he had joined shortly after receiving his Ph.D. in computer science from the same institution in December, 1996. Dr. Dionisio also works as a consultant and software developer in local industry (a.k.a. Silicon Beach). From 2002 to 2012 he helped develop health care information systems with Medaxis Corporation, a company he co-founded. Since then, he has done work for DataPop (now Criteo) in Culver City, Friendbuy in Los Angeles, and Toku Technologies in West LA. Dr. Dionisio is a member of the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM) with special interests in computer-human interaction (SIGCHI), computer graphics (SIGGRAPH), and computer science education (SIGCSE).
