Biography

Krishnan Pillaipakkamnatt is a professor in the computer science department at Hofstra University. He holds a B.E. in computer engineering (1989) from Andhra University, India and a Ph.D. in computer science (1995) from Vanderbilt University, Nashville, TN. He joined Hofstra as an assistant professor in 1995. Professor Pillaipakkamnatt's research interests lie in data mining, and machine learning. More narrowly, he is interested in algorithms that preserve an individual's privacy. A second area of research is in the pedagogy of computational thinking. He is part of a multi-disciplinary team that seeks to introduce computational thinking to high school students through app development in STEM courses.
