Dr. Loutzenheiser's current research involves an ethnography of a leadership camp for LGBTQ and TTI youth and their allies. Dr. Loutzenheiser is also conducting a policy analysis of "anti-homophobia" policy in British Columbia school boards. She is also particularly interested in the ways theories of race, sexualities, and gender are useful across research projects, methods and methodologies.
