Following ten years of teaching in the California public schools, Professor Nancy Stuart attended law school at UC Hastings, 1994. Subsequently, Professor Stuart practiced in a variety of public interest settings from litigating Voting Rights cases with the Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights to representing individuals living with HIV in an array of civil legal issues with the Hawkins Center. Professor Stuart returned to UC Hastings as a member of the faculty of the Civil Justice Clinic in July 2000. Throughout her tenure at UC Hastings, Professor Stuart was honored to learn with and from students in and out of the classroom.
