Biography

As a urologic oncologist, Dr. Paul L. Crispen specializes in the surgical treatment of cancers involving the kidney, bladder, prostate, testis and penis. His clinical interests focus on the surgical management of renal and bladder cancer, including minimally invasive techniques. While his practice focuses on the surgical management of urologic malignancies, he places great emphasis on multidisciplinary cancer care involving medical and radiation oncologists. Administratively, Dr. Crispen is an active member of the UFHealth Cancer Center and the leader of the Genitourinary Disease Site Group and the chairman of the Scientific Review and Monitoring Committee. Dr. Crispen also is an associate professor and his research interest is primarily related to improving the evaluation and treatment of patients presenting with genitourinary malignancies. To date, most of his research effort has focused on the management of bladder and kidney cancer. Additionally, he has a strong interest in involving appropriately selected patients in clinical trials which are designed to evaluate new treatment regimens and hopefully improve the care of patients at the University of Florida and beyond.
