Savage is a professor at UC San Diego's Department of Computer Science and Engineering and an affiliated faculty member at the School. His research interests are diverse, ranging from the economics of e-crime, to automotive and aviation systems to routing protocols and data center virtualization and back again. He currently serves as director of UC San Diego's Center for Network Systems (CNS) and as co-director for the Cooperative Center for Internet Epidemiology and Defenses (CCIED), a joint effort between UC San Diego and the International Computer Science Institute.
