Perry has a B.B.A. in Accountancy from Notre Dame, a J.D. from the University of Virginia, and a Ph.D. in Finance from the University of North Carolina. Perry's primary areas of research are executive compensation and corporate governance, and he has several papers published in refereed finance, accounting and law journals. Perry is also a dedicated teacher, having been honored with Kelley School of Business Evening MBA Teaching Excellence Awards in 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016 and the Eli Lilly Alumni MBA Teaching Excellence Award in 2013.
